In order to assist our residents with the costs of college education, the Friends of the Secaucus Public Library are pleased to grant a \$1,000.00 scholarship to one resident of the town of Secaucus, who will graduate high school in 2022 and will be attending college beginning in the fall of 2022.

The Friends are also honored to announce that, for the first time, we will be awarding an additional \$1500 scholarship, which is endowed through a generous donation made by the former congregation of the First Reformed Church of Secaucus and administered on their behalf.

To be eligible for consideration for both scholarships, applicants must complete the attached form and submit it to the Secaucus High School guidance office (for SHS students) by the date specified by the guidance department. Students may also submit their applications directly to the Friends of the Library by following the instructions on the Secaucus Public Library website ([secaucuslibrary.org/friends-of-the-library](http://secaucuslibrary.org/friends-of-the-library))

In addition, you must have a current Secaucus Public Library card at the time that the application is submitted to be eligible for the scholarship. If you do not have one, you can easily get one at the library during regular operating hours. To obtain a new library card, you will need to show either a school-issued photo ID card OR a NJ Driver's license OR other identification and proof of Secaucus residency.
